ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA:

In order to be considered for the Portage & Rural MS Support Bursary, applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Student whose life is affected by MS either personally, or in the family, or is pursuing post secondary education in the Science or Medical field
- Student is a current or past resident of the City or RM of Portage la Prairie
- Submit two letters of recommendation from a non-relative who is familiar with your goals and aptitude
- Official transcripts from current school's registrar

ALTERNATE CANDIDATE:

During the selection process the selection committee shall choose an alternate candidate in the event the first choice candidate fails to qualify or decides not to pursue studies as stated in their application. In order to qualify for the scholarship, the alternate candidate must have met the eligibility criteria.

Portage & Rural MS Support History

The Portage and Rural MS Support Bursary was established as a result of a group of dedicated individuals working towards helping improve the quality of life for patients and families dealing with Multiple Sclerosis. The group did not get the response expected from patients, families, volunteers and community need, so in 2020 dissolved the group and it was their hope that the people needing help will reach out to the Manitoba MS Society support group.

Despite the lack of response, the Portage and Rural MS Support received it was very successful in fundraising. It was decided to donate the funds raised to the Portage Community Foundation to create the Portage & Rural MS Support Bursary Fund. The bursary will continue the vision of the group — to help those in the Portage and surrounding rural areas, through a scholarship focused on individuals with MS, family with MS or those individuals continuing their education in the medical field.
